Situated in rainshadow region the village was highly degraded till 1992 due to very low rainfall













1993- Start of Watershed Development in Hiware Bazar

- Primary school converted to high school
- The literacy grown from 30% to 95%

Success in Water conservation and agriculture further motivated Public participation for various social works in village

Parameters speaks about success of Hiware Bazar



Due to water availability by watershed development, Cultivable land increased from 70 ha in 1993 to 260 ha in 2006.



In 2006 income from agriculture alone was 24784000. Grass production incresed from 100 MT in 2004.



Due to high increase in fodder cultivation milk production increased from 150 lpd in 1990 to 4000 lpd in 2006




In 1995 year 168 out of 182 families were BPL. In 2010 only 3 families are BPL.

By 2010 village income increased twenty fold. 50 families become *Millionaires*
