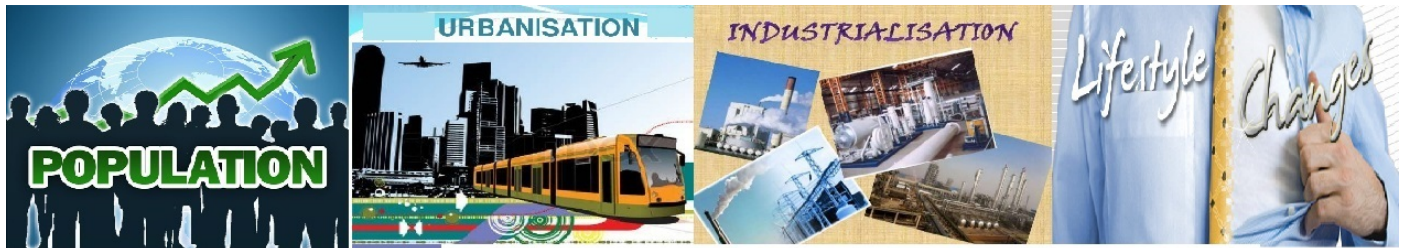
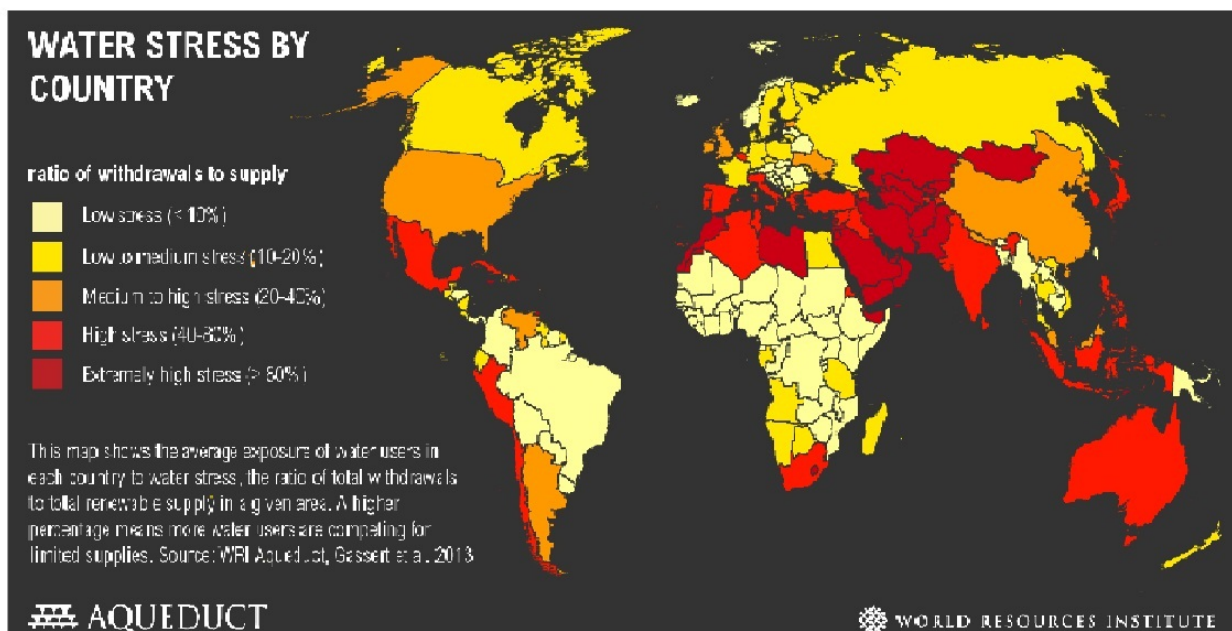
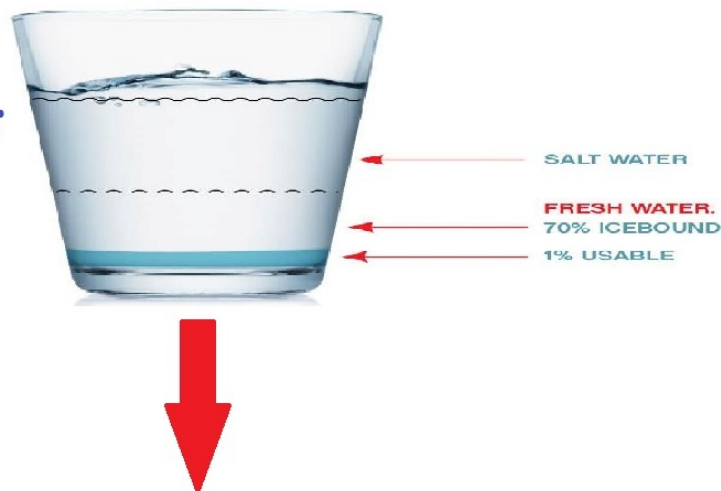


Evolution of IWRM
