
Irrigation Schemes (Govt of India)

Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojna (PMKSY)



- Launched in July 2015
- Prime Minister's initiative to ensure irrigation to every farm (Har khet ko Pani) and more productivity (Per Drop More Crop)
- PMKSY has 4 components under 3 Central government Ministries
 - 1. AIBP Ministry of Water Resources, RD&GR
 - 2. Har Khet Ko Pani (CADWM, RRR and Minor Irrigation) Ministry of Water Resources, RD&GR
 - 3. Per Drop More Crop (Micro Irrigation)- Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare
 - 4. Watershed Development (IWMP and MGNREGS)- Ministry of Rural Development

Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP)



- · Launched in 1996-97 by MoWR
- To accelerate the implementation irrigation projects
- Both Ongoing & New Major and Medium Irrigation Projects are considered.
- Minor Irrigation projects of Special Category States/Area also considered.
- Projects must have Investment clearance by Planning Commission and 4 years to complete.
- Pari passu (simultaneous) CAD implementation is compulsory
- Funding of 25% to 90% of the project Cost
- Total expenditure of around Rs. 64905.65 Cr
- About 297 projects benefited, out of which 143 completed
- 8 Million Ha of Irrigation potential created

Command Area Development & Water Management(CADWM)



- Started in 1974 to improve irrigation potential utilization.
- It includes Field Channels, Field Drains, Land leveling, Land Consolidation, Suitable Cropping Pattern, farmer's participations etc.
- Funding of 50 to 75 % of the project cost.
- 22.9 Mha of Field Channels and field drains.
- · About Rs. 5953.14 Cr released
- XII Plan allocation Rs.15,000 Cr to cover 7.6 Mha

Extension, renovation and Modernization (ERM)





- · For extending the benefits to the projects due to technological advancements
- 10 yrs or older projects considered
- Includes Head Works, Distribution System & CAD
- funding upto 90% of the project cost
- 171 projects completed
- 64 projects are ongoing.

Repair, Renovation & Restoration (RRR) of Water Bodies





- Launched in 2005.
- For RRR of traditional irrigation sources like ponds, lakes, tanks etc.
- Water bodies (5 Ha rural, 2 Ha for urban)
- Funding upto 90% of the project cost
- · 3341 water bodies covered
- 1736 water bodies completed
- Funding of Rs.852.3 Cr.

National Projects (NP)



- Approved in XII Plan to expedite completion of identified National Projects
- Funding of 90% and 75% of irrigation and drinking water components for Special and non special category States respectively
- International projects of importance, pending inter-state projects, inter-state projects of irrigation potential of 2 lakh Ha or more, ERM projects restoring irrigation potential of 2 lakh Ha or more are considered for funding
- There are 16 National Projects, 4 under execution.
- All National Projects monitored by CWC
