INTRODUCTION

The water resources sector is inherently multidisciplinary. Ensuring its sustainable development requires a skilled workforce equipped with appropriate competencies. These skills are cultivated through continual investment in training and capacity building of professionals working in the water sector. Notably, during the Workshop on Training Need Assessment for Water Resources Development and Management (WRDM), a significant recommendation was made for "Trainer/Faculty Development" to enhance the capacity of trainers for effective knowledge dissemination. In response, the National Water Academy (NWA) conceptualized and launched the *Faculty Development Program (FDP)* in 2023, aimed at strengthening the capabilities of trainers in the water sector. Since, 2023, NWA is regularly conducting the FDP Program.

In a rapidly evolving world, trainers must stay abreast of modern pedagogical methods and tools. This program addresses these challenges by equipping trainers with essential knowledge, techniques, and resources to improve their instructional effectiveness and foster professional growth. The FDP also explores critical questions such as: Who is best suited to be a trainer? What responsibilities do they bear? How can training be effectively designed and delivered?

The program emphasizes confidence-building, audience engagement, and impactful communication—enabling trainers and organizations to build internal capacities for achieving institutional objectives.
